

Lazuli Art: New Fair Trade art gallery opens in the centre of Victoria

Lazuli Art has announced the launch of a permanent new Fair Trade art gallery in the heart of Gozo. This new exhibition space is in Palm Street, Victoria, and just a short stroll from St George's Square.

Lazuli Art has opened the 2016 season with a showcase of distinctive and original metal work, featuring pieces by artists from the Caribbean island of Haiti, and Zimbabwe.

The gallery said that there is more to come from Madagascar, Burkina Faso and Morocco, as well as new initiatives such as educational workshops for schools, and cultural evenings that will infuse the art gallery with music, wine tasting and topical lectures. With each new season Lazuli Art said that it will introduce new artists and new mediums.

The gallery is open Monday to Friday from 10am to 6pm and Saturday 10am to 4pm.
